

RULES AND RESTRICTIONS FOR CLUBHOUSE RENTALS
COVID SAFETY GUIDELINES

In accordance with CDC, State and County guidelines, the MIA member agrees to comply with the following additional rules and restrictions. The MIA member is solely responsible for enforcing and complying with all MIA clubhouse rules.

COVID RISKS

1. COVID-19 is a worldwide risk to human health and is highly contagious. While people of all ages are at risk of catching COVID-19, persons with compromised immune systems and older persons may be at particular risk.
2. To reduce the spread of COVID-19, health officials from the State and County have issued mandates and recommendations limiting activities that can be engaged in by businesses and members of the public. The orders that are most restrictive take precedence.
3. The MIA member agrees to enforce and comply with all State and County health directives, regarding physical distancing and wearing face coverings when indoors or when guests cannot maintain 6 feet of distance.
4. MIA will clean and disinfect kitchen and bathroom areas before and after each event. However, this does not guarantee that all instances of viruses will be removed from the property.
5. To the best of their knowledge, the MIA member will prevent any person(s) with exposure to COVID-19 in the last 10 days, or with COVID-19 symptoms (such as cough, difficulty breathing, or fever, etc) from attending events at the MIA clubhouse.
6. The MIA member and all guests understand that hosting or attending events with multiple households may be dangerous or unsafe and can expose you or others to COVID-19.
